



State Member Protection Workshop 2017

Open to MPIOs, committee members and staff of FNSW affiliated Clubs and Associations, this full day workshop will include recognised MPIO face-to-face training, networking lunch and a special presentation “Crossing Professional Boundaries”.

MPIOs have an important role in football and provide confidential information, options and moral support to help resolve issues for members of their club or organisation.

To become an MPIO and receive a Certificate of Recognition, participants must complete an on-line training course and then attend a face-to-face workshop.

MPIO Face-to-face Training

The MPIO face-to-face training component will be completed at this Workshop and will consolidate what you’ve already learnt online. The training focuses on MPIO roles and responsibilities, listening and responding effectively, conflict of interest and impartiality, communication and promotion of the MPIO, where to get help, skills you need when dealing with people and useful resources and contact.

Networking Lunch

The day will include a networking lunch to provide opportunity to meet and discuss member protection with other MPIOs, complaint handlers, the State MPIO and workshop presenters.

Special presentation “Crossing Professional Boundaries”

Presented for the first time at a FNSW MPIO workshop, this presentation will provide valuable information to participants on crossing professional boundaries.
