Referees for MiniRoos

Consistent with Football Federation Australia MiniRoos Guidelines matches in the U6 to U11 age groups are to be facilitated by a "Game Leader". The Game Leader can be either a:

- club official;
- capable parent;
- older child or player; or
- beginner Referee;

The fees listed above are only payable to Referees registered on MyFootballClub to Referee Branches recognised by Football NSW. In this instance, should a Football Association elect to engage officially appointed Referees to facilitate **U10 and U11 matches as a Game Leader, then the fees apply.**

Football NSW does not prescribe fees for facilitation of matches in the U6 to U9 age grades.
