- (c) the Club satisfying minimum stadium requirements.

The Deed Poll relates to Clubs ensuring Club directors acknowledge they are bound by the FNSW Rules and Regulations and the FFA Rules and Regulations (as those terms are defined in the Participation Agreement) and Clubs undertaking to educate their Club Associates (as that term is defined in the Participation Agreement) about, and enforce, the FNSW Rules and Regulations and the FFA Rules and Regulations. The Deed Poll will be provided to Clubs shortly.
