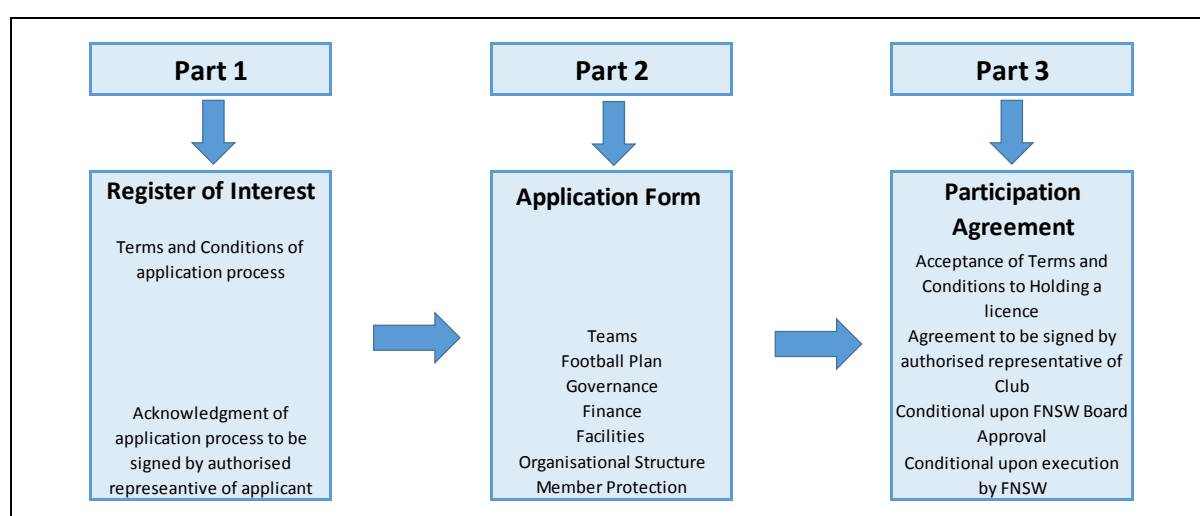


Application Process to Football NSW 2018 Competitions

The following information pertains to the 2018 Application Process to all Football NSW Men's and Women's National Premier Leagues, State League Competitions, Association Youth League, Girls Conference League and Skill Acquisition Programs (SAP & Girls SAP).

The Process

Shown below is an outline of the process being undertaken by Football NSW. In short, there are three (3) parts to the application process. This is illustrated in the table below:



Part 1 – Register of Interest

Part 1 – Register of Interest (“**Part 1**”) is the first official application document to be completed by applicants in order to be eligible to participate in the 2018 Football NSW Competitions. This will be released to applicants via our website on **Wednesday, 5 July 2017**. A notification will be sent to potential applicants via email advising them that Part 1 has been posted on the Football NSW website.

Part 1 sets out the terms and conditions that an applicant must abide throughout the entire application process. To acknowledge the terms and conditions of the application process and for an applicant to continue with the application process, they must complete the online Part 1 register of interest by **5pm Wednesday, 19 July 2017**.

Applicants should read Part 1 in its entirety to ensure they understand and are aware of the terms and conditions of the application process. Applicants may be excluded from further participation in the application process if they fail to comply with Part 1.

Part 2 – Application Form

Part 2 – Application Form (“**Part 2**”) is the second official application document to be completed by applicants in order to be eligible to participate in 2018 Football NSW Competitions. Applicants will be required to complete and submit the online Part 2 application document by **5pm Monday, 21 August 2017**.

Part 3 – Participation Agreement

Part 3 – Participation Agreement (“**Part 3**”) is the final application document to be completed by applicants in order to be eligible to participate in 2018 Football NSW Competitions. A licence to participate in 2018 Football NSW Competitions will **only** be granted to those applicant clubs admitted by the Football NSW Board to the various competitions in 2018.

Part 3 is the contractual arrangement between Football NSW and an applicant club and grants the successful applicant a licence to field teams in the NPL, SLM, NPLW, SLW, Association Youth League, Girl’s Conference League or SAP/Girls SAP Competitions for the 2018 season. Applicants are required to correctly execute and return one hard copy of Part 3 to Football NSW by **5pm Monday, 21 August 2017**.

Applicants should read Part 3 in its entirety to ensure they understand and are aware of their obligations in holding a licence to participate in the respective 2018 Football NSW Competitions.

5pm Wednesday, July 19	Due date for Applicants to submit Part 1 to FNSW
5pm Thursday, July 20	Release of Parts 2 & 3 to those Applicants who lodged Part 1
5pm Monday, August 21	Due date for Applicants to lodge Part 2 and Part 3 with FNSW
Thursday September 14	September Board Meeting
Monday September 18	Declaration of the Leagues
